SET UP AND TAKE DOWN CREW

Under the direction of the NCBS / GOF LEAD and setup crew chief, volunteers are responsible for one or more of the activities listed below. For their service and volunteering for the more strenuous tasks, they will be compensated with a stipend not to exceed \$100.00 plus the other perks granted all festival volunteers. If not completed in a timely manner, this position could continue into Monday August 12. Check in at volunteer booth is required to receive a lanyard.

A Volunteer Release of Liability agreement will be required for this position; see attached.

- 1. Report to work no later than 8:00 am or as requested by crew chief.
- 2. Use a truck with tow bar to move trailer around SBHS park.
- 3. Move trailer from storage area to main field and back at end of festival.
- 4. Unload and separate equipment, stages and EZ-ups and miscellaneous gear as requested.
- 5. Raise shade cloth over the main seating area.
- 6. Assemble all stages as required.
- 7. Assemble all EZ-ups, stage covers and NCBS booths as requested.
- 8. Put up fencing as required for kids' area and backstage if required.
- 9. Move picnic tables and return them to original locations at end of festival as requested.
- 10. Take down shade cloth, stages, and EZ-ups at end of festival as requested.
- 11. Reload storage truck, all festival equipment, stages, shade cloth, booths, storage containers and miscellaneous gear as requested.
- 12. Park storage truck in original position.
- 13. Cover storage truck with tarp and strap down.
- 14. Lock storage truck with supplied locks.
- 15. See NCBS LEAD for compensation at completion of all tasks.

I understand and agree to the volunteer work required above and will complete the tasks as a team until the storage trailer is secured in its original position and all the tasks listed above are completed before I will receive any compensation for my service unless agreed upon by NCBS LEAD. I also understand that this position could lead into working additional time on Monday (August 11) if not completed by the close of day on Sunday (August 10).
